Vinmonopolet has the exclusive right to sell spirits, wine and strong beer to consumers, and is a wholly state-owned joint stock company under the Ministry of Health and Care Services. Vinmonopolet is a government-owned alcoholic beverage retailer and the only company allowed to sell beverages containing an alcohol content higher than 4.75% in Norway. Below this alvohol percentage beverages are sold in grocery shops with time restriction.

Alexander Michaelsen, Product Manager for France, South America and Eastern Europe for Oslo-based Vinmonopolet. Alexander is responsible for writing tenders for France, South America and Eastern Europe. It is also his responsibility to ensure that the Vinmonopolet assortment is balanced with a fair share of products that are certified as ethical, sustainable, organic and biodynamic, and products that are bottled in environmentally friendly packaging. He enjoys meeting wine importers, wine producers and travelling to vineyards in the countries he is responsible for.





Svein Bognar is the owner of House of Hungary in Norway. House of Hungary is a new addition to the Norwegian culinary heaven and wants to make Hungarian culinary products available to the Norwegian market including good quality Hungarian wines. Svein will talk about his experiences, the do's and don'ts when importing product to Norway.
