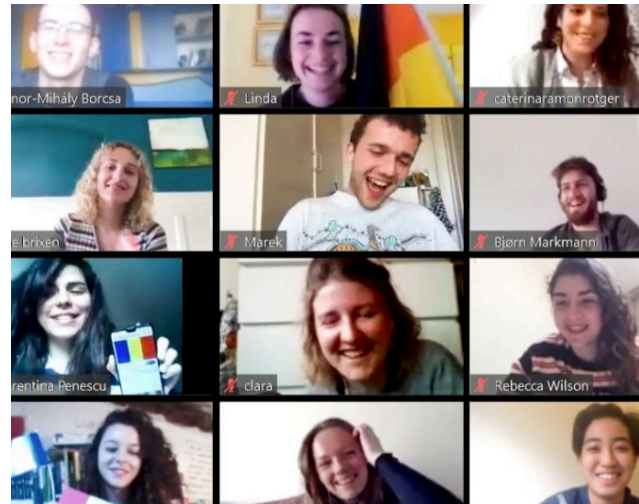


The Academy of Change is a training course for young people who want to work on climate, social and economic justice, get skilled in methods of change and become part of an international youth network.

TOOLS

When we have investigated what we want to change, we need to know how to do it! For this we need tools that help us act within and influence our surroundings. At the Academy you will get practical tools within:

- Social movements
- Advocacy training
 - Storytelling
- Written and oral communication
 - Digital activism

Joining the Academy **does not require any prior knowledge** of economics, climate policies or transformative practices, only that you have **a desire to get involved** in the course and exchange ideas and your own experiences with the other participants. It is **free of charge to participate** in the Academy, but in return we expect you to **actively participate** throughout the whole course.

Participants will be selected based on **personal motivation** and on creating a **diverse and interdisciplinary group**. We encourage everyone **regardless of gender, religion, or ethnicity to sign up**.
